I also find the staff extremely supportive to myself as a relative of a resident living with dementia. There is a regular support group for families run by the staff and this is a wonderful venue to share information and provide support for each other. Dementia is a relentless disease and being able to share with others in the same position is very helpful. I have found the menu provided for all residents to be second to none, with a great variety and allowances for individual tastes. I would not hesitate to recommend Moonah Park to any one looking to find a loving, person centred environment for their loved one with dementia.

Moonah Park tout themselves as a Centre of Excellence in Dementia Care (CEDC). Unfortunately, nothing could be further from the truth. The staff are ill equipped to deal with dementia residents. They are trained only to the minimum standard required in order for the facility to meet government guidelines. My mother was left for more than a day in several

instances lying in her own urine as the staff could not, or would not shower her. The food is substandard, and the cottage environment, which is designed to be a centre of stimulation and activities for the dementia residents, was devoid of activities with most residents sitting around staring at the grass outside or the walls inside. Meanwhile, 2 or more staff sat lazily behind the desk in the living room chatting to each other, or taking cigarette breaks. Awful place and please do not be fooled by the modern and inviting facade.
